WHEREAS: The Township of Blissfield may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public service, as authorized the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws and

WHEREAS: Township of Blissfield wishes to renew 1.4737 mills for Roads; .9825 mills for Fire Operations; .0175 mills for Fire Operations; .5000mills for Fire Operations/Equipment; and 1.000mills to be inclusive for Operations, Daytime Staffing, and Special Equipment Truck Purchases

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township of Blissfield Board approves the following millage ballot question language and directs the Clerk to submit these to be placed on the August 4, 2026 election ballot.

WHEREAS: The Township of Blissfield may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public service, as authorized the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws and

WHEREAS: Township of Blissfield wishes to renew 1.4737 mills for Roads;.9825 mills for Fire Operations;.0175 mills for Fire Operations; .5000mills for Fire Operations/Equipment; and 1.000mills to be inclusive for Operations, Daytime Staffing, and Special Equipment Truck Purchases, pending language approval of legal counsel.
